We know some parts of this website are not fully accessible:

This website is partially compliant with the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.2](#) AA standard, due to the non-compliances listed below:

Non-accessible content

The content listed below is non-accessible for the following reasons.

Some of our PDFs and Word documents are essential to providing our services. For example meeting and policy documents. All documents published after 31 March 2026 onwards are accessible PDFs wherever possible.

The accessibility regulations [do not require us to fix PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018](#) if they're not essential to providing our services. For example, we do not plan to fix old meeting documents such as agendas and minutes.

Disproportionate burden

Some PDF documents are not fully accessible to screen reader software. We've assessed the time required to fix the issue and we believe that doing so now for all documents would be a disproportionate burden within the meaning of the accessibility regulations. We will review this at our next accessibility review.

Content that's not within the scope of the accessibility regulations

The accessibility regulations [do not require us to fix PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018](#) if they're not essential to providing our services.
